#3 CASEY ROBERTSON

– A true team-oriented 5'6" Point Guard who handles the ball exceptionally well, floor-generals the team with great direction and vision. She is a tenacious defensive player with speed, quickness and 22" vertical leap.

#10 BRITTANY ROSS

– A very quick 5' 6" 1, 2, or 3 Guard with extreme speed who loves to run the floor and find teammates. A great threat from the 3-point range and a solid defensive player.

#21 AMANDA BADE

– An all-around 6' Forward who can penetrate off the dribble, and shoot the 15' jump shot. She can execute the offense or can create offense on her own.

#23 TARYN

BRIDGWATERS – A gifted 5' 9" athlete that played all four of five positions in 2003-2004 for her high school over a span of 17 games, helping the school maintain the number one ranking in the top class of Indiana high school basketball during that time. A very tough defender, excellent jumper and strong one-on-one player.

#24 LACEY WORKMAN

– A versatile 5' 9" Guard/Forward that plays the 1, 2, 3 positions. She can drive and is an excellent free-throw and spot-up shooter with good range. She is aggressive defensively with good speed and dribbling skills.

#25 CHARISSE HICKS

– A great defensive 5' 7" Guard that can run the floor and provides a scoring threat. Good free-throw and medium-range shooter; possess good quickness and ball control.

#31 MOLLY LAUCK

– A 6" small and power Forward who plays the 3, 4, 5 positions. She is comfortable running the floor and in a set, half-court offense. She is a good rebounder and has good hands to catch entry passes.

#33 REBECCA HOWERTON

– A strong 6' 2 Center that rebounds and scores in the post. She runs the court well and has good hands to receive entry passes; the past high school season she averaged double figures in rebounding.

#35 KIMBERLY

ROBERSON – An aggressive 5' 10 Guard/Forward that plays the 1, 2, 3 positions. She can penetrate off the dribble, shoot with range, and can be unstoppable at times. A terrific scorer who passes well and has great reach, quick hands, jumping ability, speed, and dribbling skills.

#42 KRIS CONER

– An exceptionally strong 6' 1" Center who impacts the game at both ends of the floor. She is an outstanding rebounder with good hands and a good shooting touch around the basket.

An aggressive 5' 10 Guard/Forward that plays the 1, 2, 3 positions.

She can penetrate off the dribble, shoot with range, and can be unstoppable at times. Good Free throw shooter and good under pressure.
